## UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC PRELATE TO BE RECOGNIZED AS PATRIARCH?

There are six Eastern Catholic *patriarchates*: (1) the <u>Coptic Catholic Church</u>, which is based in Egypt and is governed by the *patriarch* of Alexandria; (2, 3 & 4) three of Antioch, (one each for the Syrians, Maronites, and Greek Melkites); the <u>Chaldean Catholic Church</u>, which is based in <u>Baghdad</u> and is governed by the *patriarch* of Babylon of the Chaldeans (5); and the <u>Armenian Catholic Church</u>, which is based in Lebanon and is governed by the *katholikos* of Sis, or <u>Cilicia</u> (6).

But one Eastern Catholic Church, the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church does not have a *Patriarch*. Instead it has a *Major Archbishop*. Why? So as not to offend the Russian Orthodox Church!

**Guns: Promises Not Kept** 



Amid a rising gun homicide rate and a growing debate over what to do about it, The National's special series on gun violence takes a closer look at gun control laws. Some say they persecute, others say they protect, but in recent years the trend has been toward looser laws. - CBC National

Politicians are voted into power with the promise that they will act to reduce gun proliferation in Canada. As explained in the video, lawmakers move 5 steps forward then the next elected group retracts 6 steps and the current government is moving one step forward. The result is looser laws.

#### Our National Minister has recently written:

Dear Regional Ministers,

You will have already received a copy of the letter that I sent to the Minister of Public Safety, the Honourable Marco Mendicino, regarding the strengthening of gun control laws in Canada. Attached is a template of this letter that I would invite you to circulate within your region and to ask local fraternities to also send a letter to Minister Mendicino to voice their support of this legislation. As bearers of peace, we can do no less. At a minimum, all that needs to be added to the letter is the date, along with the name, position and signature of the sender. Of course, you may wish to add or change the text to personalize the letter as needed. Clearly, more letters will have a greater impact on government officials than a single letter from the National Minister.




Permanent Astonishment: A Memoir
